

The New Bill Act

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the United States of America.

Sec. 1. Cleaning up the way laws are made.

- a) Any proposed bill will be simple and written in plain language. **look to this as a blueprint of simplicity. How do you expect someone who didn't go to law school to understand something full of legal ease?**
- b) No amendments will be allowed that are not related to the original bill. **This is a deceptive practice that never should have been started. No more hiding things that couldn't pass on their own, doing favors or creating loopholes.**
- c) No bill shall have an excessive amount of amendments.
- d) Ample time will be given to read any new bill.
- e) No information shall be withheld prior to voting. **Nancy Pelosi "We have to pass the bill so that you can find out what is in it"**

Sec. 2. Guidelines.

- a) A bill with more than 5 amendments should be broken in to more than one bill.
- b) Bills shall be 20 pages or under. **(Far to much can, and has, slip threw the cracks in a 1500 page document full of legal ease.)**
- c) One week should be given to read and research a new bill.
- d) All bills must be Clear, Fair, and Equally Enforceable.
